HELPFUL QUESTIONS ART & ENTERTAINMENT

1 SEATING AVAILABILITY

What types of seating options are available?

Some possible options are:

- Wheelchair accessible seating
- Easily accessible seating
- Seating to accommodate eyesight/hearing difficulties
- If outdoors is seating provided

Other Possible Helpful Amenities:

- Magnifying glass for visual performance art
- Headphones with hearing aid assistance
- Larger print information sheets
- ADA compliant
- Elevator
- Handicap accessible restroom
- Parking accessibility

Is it crowded?

For those struggling with mobility easily accessible entertainment is important. Crowded rooms make it hard to move about and see where you're going. .

2 COSTS

What is the cost? Is there a discount for seniors?

There may be a fixed cost per person or it may vary depending on age and group size. If there is a senior discount there will be an age requirement of qualifying for the discount.

3 SWEARING & INAPPROPRIATE WORDS

Is there excessive swearing, language or visuals some may view as inappropriate?

In performance art some individuals may be bothered by the language or visuals used, asking beforehand can ensure the right entertainment option is chosen.

Is there excessive violence in the performance?

If one is bothered by violence in performances, they should be prepared for what is going to be shown

5 LENGTH OF EVENT

How long is the event and is there an intermission?
